Direct Action Group (CC):

This Group has not met for some time, and has been superseded by other sub Groups formed after Public Meetings and the Village questionnaire results (4 Key Themes). Need to re-define purpose and focus....possibly as Pathways/Environment theme.

Agreed to list achievements/ongoing projects and future targets to decide how to go forward CC

Events(KB):

Minshull Madness agreed for Saturday 6th July at Badger Field. Free event if possible with donation bucket(s) available. Sports events as per Jubilee 2012 with professional ceilidh band later with caller. BBQ/Bar to be set up and run by DH and Badger Team

Grant of £250 secured via Cheshire East Council....further Grant application still outstanding for £900. (Big Lottery) Possibly a donation from the Parish Council.

Opera /Wine tasting event being investigated

Cheshire Rural Touring Arts Group: CMV now official Promoter for this Group...."Menu" of events available from Children's shows to plays etc etc. Cheshire East will fund 50%.....50% of any profit goes to Touring Arts Group with 50% to Events Group......Accommodation to be provided for touring performers /support by local residents.

Events Group identified need for store of equipment for future events....possible/consideration of a container to be housed at rear of Badger? ACTION ALL ABOVE.....KB/TEAM

Broadband:

Funding been secured for upgrade of Village website...will be done in near future LB/Meikle Carss

Connecting Cheshire Partnership has secured funding to increase speed of broadband dramatically in Rural Areas in next 2 years....pressure needs to be kept on to make this happen

2PC's have been kindly donated to CMV by Meikle Carss.....need to decide where to place them

Final plan for traffic calming measures in Village to be discussed with MJ as a matter of urgency DW..

Plans still due to be implemented late July.....possibility of full resurfacing of road through the centre of the Village.

Parish Council(DW)

Peter Harper retired after 18 yearsVacancy for his replacement to be advertised.

New Parish Clerk...Lucy Hassall started Monday 20th May Co-operation with Canal & River Trust resulted in new steps at Bridge 12 and discussions about work to put steps down to canal at Bridge 11(Old Hoolgrave).....work agreed in principle...funding of materials to be discussed. Section of Canal between bridges 11 & 15 to be adopted by PC for such things as, litter-picking. More Volunteers have come forward for this which is excellent news.

PCC: (CC)

Parish and other 3 in Benefice will become Interregnum when Vicar leaves on 9th May. Process to find successor will be conducted by Bishop of Chester. 4parishes will come back together with another option to join these 4 with 3 in the Wrenbury area......yet to be decided.

Messy Church led by SC going from strength to strength...new families coming.

Roof replacement....agreement in principle to re cover the whole roof...cost c£35k....currently £9k short.

Work ongoing in the Churchyard....grant of £1k generously given by PCouncil to further this...especially the renovation of the Entrance Gates.
