5. Cheshire Rural Touring Arts Group:

60 tickets - sold out. Half of the profits back to CRT Arts Group/ over to CM Vision Steering Group. Cost of village hall 7pm-11pm,and electricity from 4pm covered by CM Vision Steering Group.

6. Website upgrade and launch date:

Brand new look and name. Preview to P.C. Full support given. Launch date Monday 4 November 2013 in the village hall. Will be advertised on current website, Insight and using a banner. News will transfer to new site. Small issue of strong enough wi-fi signal.

7. Broadband:

Community need to set up a Broadband plan. This will be actioned after the play when more time. Plans will be presented to Connecting Cheshire. More people to register their interest.

Approached by Sandra Wallis re the Village Hall becoming a Hub. Link with the Broadband plan leading to a possible internet cafe for the community. This could lead to IT lessons and training, Business meetings as well as more shows in the village hall. Link to Wren for possible funding (such as sound equipment enabling more shows to be produced). Streaming movies also a possibility. To start early 2014 due to other priorities. Possible sub group.

WiFi / Broadband in village hall:

Can Village Hall be connected to broadband/WiFi? Cost?

PC -

Overgrown hedges – The village has a small issue with overgrown hedges encroaching across pedestrian footways. KB suggested drafting a letter to residents of properties which front on to public footways (mainly in the village centre) to suggest a hedge cutting weekend. DW suggested a walk-around to determine footway access. This agenda item was not discussed at this meeting we need to carry over.
