



## Policy Statement Charities

Church Minshull Parish Council will consider requests for publicising charity events and appeals for charitable donations, on the following principles of policy:

- 1. That publicity requests and donation appeals from charity organisations within the civil parish of Church Minshull will be considered in priority;
- 2. That publicity requests and donation appeals from other local charity organisations outside the civil parish of Church Minshull, need indicate they provide a beneficial service to Church Minshull residents, to allow the Council to consider them;
- 3. That the Council will consider the general benefit to its local community and would not, therefore, require evidence of specific benefit to any individual/s, at any particular point of time;
- 4. That charitable donations, based on the above principles, would be considered, within a budget set by the Council;
- 5. That donation appeals from national charity organisations will not be considered, despite indications that there may be an indirect benefit to the Council's local community;
- 6. That publicity requests from local charity organisations will be placed on its website and also re-directed to the local publications and notice boards;
- 7. That publicity requests from national charity organisations will re-directed to the local publications and notice boards.
