

Carriageway improvement work starting in your area

What is happening

We are pleased to inform you that we will be carrying out carriageway improvement work along **Cross Lane, Church Minshull**.

When it's happening

Works to deliver carriageway improvements are scheduled to start on **15 October 2025** and will take approximately **3 days** to complete, weather dependant. During this period a road closure will be in place between the hours of **09:30** and **15:30** and access will be maintained.

Under current Health and Safety legislation, a **road closure** will be necessary at all times during these works for the safety of our workforce and members of the public. We understand there is no right time to undertake this work. However, the scheme has been carefully planned to minimise any inconvenience to you and other road users. Please note that we occasionally change our works at short notice due to unforeseen circumstances such as adverse weather conditions or logistics.

What you can expect

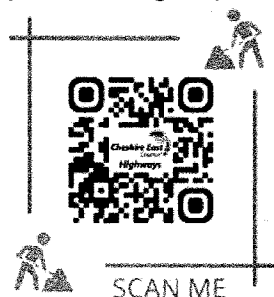
- Signage on street in advance of the work starting
- Our team working on the carriageway and footway
- Machinery and vehicles
- Barrired areas to create safe working zones, in line with current Health & Safety legislation
- 'Business open as usual', 'Road Closed Ahead/Diversion' and 'Cyclist dismount' signs
- Bus services will continue during the closure and waste collection will not be affected.

Access to your property or business

We will make every effort to maintain vehicle access to your property or business. However, due to the nature of the works some inconvenience may still occur and there could be times when point of entry will vary. Please note, this letter does not grant you access through the road closure. If you have any specific access requirements, please raise these with our site supervisor as soon as possible.

Your safety and the safety of our workforce is our priority. Our Traffic Management Officers will be supplied with CCTV cameras and they will assist you as the work progresses.
